To Whom It May Concern:

On March 24, 2015 and March 27, 2015, the parties listed above filed revisions to their respective Open Access Transmission Tariffs,¹ in the docket numbers listed above, in compliance with the Commission's order issued on January 23, 2015, as it relates to the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council, Inc. (FRCC) and Southeastern Regional Transmission Planning (SERTP) pair of neighboring transmission planning regions.² The

January 23, 2015 Order addressed the parties' compliance with the interregional transmission coordination and cost allocation requirements of Order No. 1000.³

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittals are accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2015, as requested.

The filings were noticed on March 24, 2015, March 25, 2015 and April 3, 2015, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before April 14, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2014)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the Florida Filing Parties or the SERTP Filing Parties.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
