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Reference: Order No. 1000 Interregional Compliance Filings

To Whom It May Concern:

On March 24, 2015, the parties listed above filed revisions to their respective Open Access Transmission Tariffs,¹ in the docket numbers listed above, in compliance with the Commission's order issued on January 23, 2015, as it relates to the South Carolina Regional Transmission Planning (SCRTP) and Southeastern Regional Transmission Planning (SERTP) pair of neighboring transmission planning regions.² The January 23, 2015 Order addressed the parties' compliance with the interregional transmission coordination and cost allocation requirements of Order No. 1000.³

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittals are accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2015.

The filings were noticed on March 24, 2015, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before April 14, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2014)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
